## **Junior Apologetics Questions**

During competition, you will receive the question(s) with the answer(s) from the catechism on a slip of paper as the starting place for your speech.

- Who made you? God.
  What else did God make? God made all things.
- 2. Why did God make you and all things? For his own glory.
- How can you glorify God? By loving him and doing what he commands.
- Why ought you to glorify God? Because he made me and takes care of me.
- 5. Are there more gods than one? There is only one God.
- 6. In how many persons does this one God exist? In three persons.What are they?

- 7. Where is God? God is everywhere.
- Can you see God? No; I cannot see God, but he always sees me.
- 9. Does God know all things? Yes; nothing can be hid from God.
- **10. Can God do all things?** Yes; God can do all his holy will.
